Event booking must meet a \$500 service minimum.

Certain event bookings (such as Estes Park or Colorado Springs) must meet a \$700 service minimum, depending on location (and will incur a Travel Fee).

Service minimum can be met by any combination of services that total the applicable amount - trial included.

If service minimum can't be met by multiple services that total the amount, the applicable minimum amount will be charged.

Additional fees (such as Travel Fee, etc.) do not count towards the service minimum.

Trial does count towards the service minimum.

FAQ

How does the booking process work? Do you require a deposit?

Ready to get glammed? I can't wait to meet you! Here's a rundown of the booking process. Your date is considered reserved and booked once the contract has been completed and deposit has been paid. To proceed with booking, you will first fill out the contract, then we will get on a phone call for me to get your CC information, and I will charge your deposit at that time as well. Your deposit is 50% of your estimated total cost. Your remaining balance gets charged on the day of the event, upon completion of services. A 3.5% credit card fee will be added to your final estimated total. Any services and/or fees added or products sold after the deposit has been paid will be added to the remaining balance.

When can I schedule a trial?

A trial is essential for customizing your look based on your desires, and ensures for a timely and organized execution on the day of the event. Having a trial also enables me to see and work with your skin in advance of the event, and it's our time to chat all things makeup, skincare, tips, and tricks. Plus, it's when we get to meet and hang out for the first time!

Your trial is scheduled once the event has been booked and the booking process is complete.

While places like traditional salons offer trials at any time, due to the nature of my varying schedule, (I might be at a wedding, or I'm on a photo shoot, sometimes I'm having an office day - every day is different!) I see you for your trial after your booking process is complete.

Trials are scheduled Monday-Thursday, no more than 3 months prior to your event. Trials cannot be scheduled on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, except for during the off-season (aka the dead of winter!).

Your trial will take place either at your location, depending on location and availability, or from my home studio just outside of Boulder. Additional fees may apply.

Trial service and day of the event service must be the same (ex - if choosing Full Face with Airbrush for the day of the event, Full Face with Airbrush must also be done at the trial). Please arrive to your trial clean-faced with no makeup on - a gentle moisturizer is fine.

Live outside of Colorado and can't get a trial? No problem! You'll just have to fill out a separate Trial Waiver Form in addition to your contract and an additional 30 minutes will be added to the service time on the day of the event.

Do you travel? Is there a Travel Fee?

I primarily service the Denver/Boulder area of Colorado with no Travel Fee. To find out where I travel to or if you will incur a Travel Fee to your location, contact info@dasharoberts glam.com.

Are there any other fees?

Additional fees (such as Early Start Fee, etc.) may apply. Contact info@dasharoberts glam.com with the details of your day to find out more.

Do you provide hair services?

I exclusively provide makeup services.

Hairstylist recommendations available upon request, with event booking.

I need makeup for myself only, or maybe my mom too. Do you do elopements?

Event booking must meet a \$500 service minimum. Certain event bookings (such as Estes Park or Colorado Springs) must meet a \$700 service minimum, depending on location. I can totally accept elopements! Or a small group of 2 or 3. However, the applicable service minimum amount will be charged, if service minimum can't be met.

Can you accommodate large groups?

*I can accommodate groups of up to 12 at this time.
Additional Artist Fee applies for groups of 9+.*

I have to be ready by a certain time. How does timing work?

I determine my start time based off of your group size and required end time - whether that be the time you need to leave by, the time you need to start photos by, etc. I schedule additional time than what is needed to serve as a buffer of time (for obvious reasons!), so you can typically expect to be complete prior to your scheduled end time.

Can I add more services or change my location later on?

If things change on your end throughout your planning process, the day of the event timing and location details can typically be changed with no issue, however all change requests must be approved in advance of the event. Other fees may then become applicable (such as Early Start Fee and/or Travel Fee), depending on your needs. You can add or change services as well. If service count falls below the applicable service minimum and the minimum can no longer be met by multiple services that total the amount, the applicable minimum amount will be charged. If service count becomes 9+, an additional artist and an Additional Artist Fee will be added. Additional artist cannot necessarily be secured if not booked in advance.

I have sensitive skin. Can I bring my own makeup? Will you have my skin tone?

I begin every application by asking, "Do you have any allergies or sensitivities?" Please report any known allergies and/or skin conditions prior to application and, if needed, a sample test of makeup may be performed on the skin to test for reaction.

I come with a fully stoked, professional kit with everything we need, as well as an arsenal of knowledge and an extensive background working with all skin tones, types, conditions, ethnicities, and genders over the last decade.

So, if you're wondering if I've done makeup on people of color, including Black, Asian, and Indian decent, people that are non-binary, trans, LGBTQ+, men, twins, burn victims, cancer patients, people with sensitive skin, mature skin, acne-prone skin, rosacea, hyperpigmentation, scars, texture, etc. - the answer is yes!

If there is something specific that someone would like for me to use of theirs, feel free to bring it along, and I'll use your products at my discretion.

I'm having a brunch wedding. Will my makeup last all day?

By using professional products and techniques, you can rest assured that your makeup will last all day. However, there are parameters, of course! So, you'll want to make sure that you aren't rubbing or smearing the face throughout the day. When we meet for your trial, I will supply you with some tips for crying and touch ups (or you can choose to keep me around for touch ups throughout the day). Check out my reviews to see how some brides described their makeup at the end of their wedding night.

I've never done airbrush makeup before. Does it feel or look heavy on the skin?

Nope, airbrush makeup is the opposite of heavy! It is a spray foundation that is applied through an airbrush machine using compressed air. It creates a flawless finish and feels like a light mist on the skin - because it is! Its method of application makes it wonderful for those with sensitive skin. It holds up under heat, is long-lasting, and is recommended for weddings or for anyone who is on camera.
